This is a quick start guide to help you access all the features and benefits of your Georgia Homeschooling membership! Follow the steps below to get the most out of your homeschool experience. If you don't already have a membership, [Sign Up Here](#).

Step 1: Login

In order to access all the online tools and reports, it's important that you first login to the website.

Visit [My Dashboard](#) to login with your Email and Password that you created during sign up.

Step 2: Change the Current School Year

Each year that you start homeschooling, it's important to take this action. You can always change the school year dates to previous years to generate old reports and view attendance data.

A. Visit [My Dashboard](#) and click the Change School Year Dates button to set the current school year.

B. Choose a School Start Date and School End Date for the current school year and click Save. Keep in mind that you need at least 180 days of school. Typically, a school year goes from August/September through May/June, but this is totally up to you.

C. Note: Before changing to the next school year, we recommend that you first generate any Attendance Records and Reports for the current school year. You can always go back, but it's just easier to do generate reports before switching to the next school year.






Before you are able to generate reports, or download and print documents, you first need to add your children.

B. For each student, be sure to add their First and Last Name, Date of Birth, and upload a profile image.

Submit New Declaration of Intent Form

As a Georgia Homeschooler, you are required to submit a Declaration of Intent Form every year that you homeschool. To submit your form, simply click the Submit New Declaration of Intent Form button above. This will take you to the official Georgia Home Study Program Declaration of Intent Form where you will need to complete the online form and submit it online. You must submit your form within 30 days of starting homeschool or by September 1st.

If you would rather mail or fax your Declaration of Intent Form, you can [Download the Form Here](#).

This page is for record keeping only. This is not an official record of your Declaration of Intent Form submission. You are responsible for either submitting the form online, by mail, or fax.

Georgia law requires parents or guardians who teach their children at home to submit to the Georgia Department of Education (GADOE) an annual Declaration of Intent form. A Declaration of Intent must be submitted to the Georgia Department of Education within 30 days after establishment of a home study program and by September 1 annually thereafter.

A. Visit [My Dashboard](#) and click the Declaration of Intent tab on the left side of the screen.

B. Choose one of the following options:

Click the Submit New Declaration of Intent Form button to submit online.
Click the Download the Form Here link to print form and submit via Fax/Mail.

C. Once you click either option, your Georgia Homeschooling Declaration of Intent page will refresh and show you the Date and Time that you submitted the form.

IMPORTANT: The date and time you submitted the form that shows on your Declaration of Intent page is just for record keeping and does not mean that the form has been officially submitted to the Georgia DOE. **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE** for submitting the Declaration of Intent form either Online or by Fax/Mail.

D. If you choose to submit online, you will be redirected to the Georgia DOE page where you can complete the form for all your children and submit the form online. We will send you a reminder email to do this each year after you change your school year dates to the next school year.

If you choose to submit via Fax/Mail, you must complete the paper form and either Fax or Mail it to the address on the form.

A. Attendance Tracker

Visit [My Dashboard](#), click on a Student Profile, and click on the Attendance tab.

Check Total Attendance - As you progress through the school year, adding days to the student profile Attendance calendar, the Total Attendance will update with your total days of homeschooling so that you can keep track of your progress to 180 days.

Select All Monday-Friday - This option lets you select all the days Monday-Friday of the Current School Year for this student. You can then deselect any holidays or days that you did not homeschool.

Clear All - This option lets you clear all the days of the Current School Year for this student. A warning popup will appear to confirm this action.

From here, you can do the following:

Update Attendance Records for All Children - The Family Attendance Tracker page shows all your students on one page. Here, you can quickly and easily update the attendance records of all your children. This is a great solution if all your children have the same homeschool schedule.

Download Attendance Records - Click the Download Attendance Records button under each student profile to download the attendance report for this student for the Current School Year that you have set in your My Dashboard.

Select Individual Attendance Days - Each day that you homeschool 4.5 hours, you can individually mark that day on the Attendance calendar for each student. You can do this as you go, weekly, monthly, or yearly. After selecting days, it will automatically save your progress.

Select All Monday-Friday - This option lets you select all the days Monday-Friday of the Current School Year for ALL STUDENTS. You can then deselect any holidays or days that you did not homeschool.

Clear All - This option lets you clear all the days of the Current School Year for ALL STUDENTS. A warning popup will appear to confirm this action.

C. Declaration of Intent Forms

Visit [My Dashboard](#) and click on the Declaration of Intent tab on the left. You can also access your Declaration of Intent submissions with your Student Profile page on the Declaration of Intent tab.

Note: Whenever you click the Submit New Declaration of Intent Form button or the Download the Form Here link, it will document the Date and Time that you click those links to help you keep track. IMPORTANT: The date and time you submitted the form that shows on your Declaration of Intent page is just for record keeping and does not mean that the form has been officially submitted to the Georgia DOE. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE for submitting the Declaration of Intent form either Online or by Fax/Mail. Also, only one Declaration of Intent form is required to be submitted each year for your entire family.

Georgia law requires parents or guardians who teach their children at home to submit to the Georgia Department of Education (GADOE) an annual Declaration of Intent form. A Declaration of Intent must be submitted to the Georgia Department of Education within 30 days after establishment of a home study program and by September 1 annually thereafter.

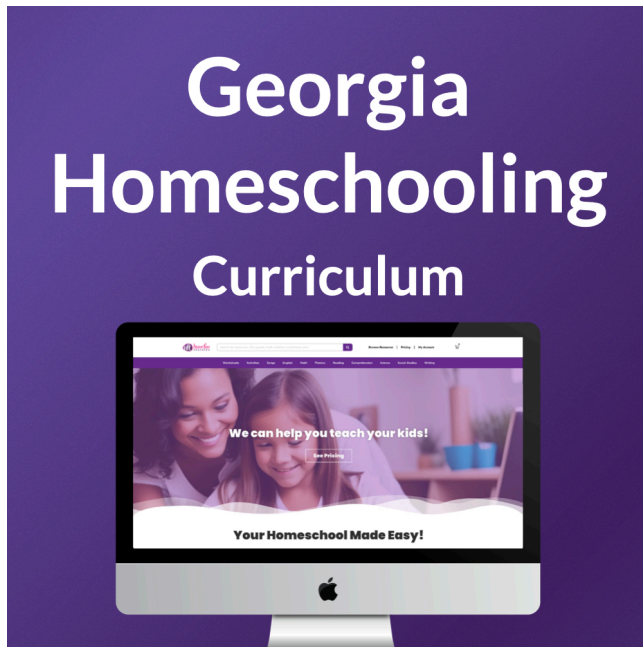
